



ENTRY FORM 20th Annual Awards
Deadline: Monday, January 11, 2016
Organized by The Foreign Correspondents' Club Hong Kong,
Amnesty International Hong Kong and the Hong Kong Journalists Association.

ELIGIBILITY The Awards are open to:

- Journalists based in Hong Kong or Macau.
- Correspondents reporting in the Asian region.

WORKS MUST BE

- In English or Chinese.
- Published or broadcast in the professional news media. We do not accept works used as publicity for corporations or activist groups.
- Published or broadcast during the past calendar year, January 1 to December 31, 2015.
- Reported from the Asian region. We define this as Afghanistan in the West to Japan in the East, Mongolia in the North to Indonesia in the South. We include Central Asia, but not the Middle East. Works from Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific will be considered if they address broader Asian issues.
- Related to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (www.un.org/Overview/rights.html)

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- We will accept no more than 3 entries per journalist. In some cases, series of multiple works can constitute one entry. Please see below for details.
- We prefer that applicants submit via our website, *HumanRightsPressAwards.org*. A code number will be emailed to you after your submission. If you need to supplement your entry with mailed materials like clips, photos, DVDs, etc, please cite this code number and label all materials clearly. We cannot guarantee the return of physical materials.
- The deadline is *January 11, 2016*. No late entries will be accepted.
- There is no entry fee.
- If you cannot submit digitally, you can use this form. Downloadable PDFs are available at *HumanRightsPressAwards.org*. Print forms are also available at the Foreign Correspondents' Club (see below)

JUDGING & AWARDS

Our three volunteer judging panels - English, Chinese and Photography - are comprised of leaders in the fields of journalism, academia, law and human rights.

Winners will be announced at our annual Awards Ceremony on Friday, May 6, 2016. Short-listed candidates, plus their editors and producers, are welcome to attend.

Prizes are given to individual journalists, not media companies. - with the exception of un-bylined opinion pieces. Plaques, certificates and prizes should go directly to the journalist. Companies can order duplicate plaques or certificates by emailing **info@HumanRightsPressAwards.org**

CATEGORIES

TEXT & PRINT This includes newspapers, magazines, journals, wire services and other text-based media. Entries are divided into these categories:

- Spot news
- Features
- Commentary
- Cartoon & illustration

For a series of work, all of which must have been published, choose the top 2 articles and provide a brief summary of the rest.

ONLINE This category applies to:

- Online-only media.
- Multimedia works that are best viewed as an online package and do not fit easily into a single traditional category.

A URL is required for this category. Please note that we do not accept self-published works.

CARTOONS & ILLUSTRATIONS Provide 2 paper copies of the cartoon or illustration. You may also send a JPEG or other digital copies.

TELEVISION & VIDEO We prefer DVD Video or MP4 video files on a data DVD. We also accept MediaPlayer or QuickTime files. If the work is available online, please include a URL.

RADIO & AUDIO We accept MP3 files. If the work is available online, please include a URL.

PHOTOGRAPHY Entries are divided into two categories:

- Spot news - strong, single news images.
- Features - series of multiple images that comprise a photo essay or magazine spread. All images must have been published.

We accept JPEGs with a quality setting of eight (8) or above. They should be a minimum of 2,000 pixels on the short side. Include the credit and caption information in the metadata. If you are submitting multiple photos on one disk, it may be helpful to also include the credits and captions on an MS Word file, clearly marking the JPEG file names. You may provide print-outs or publication clips for reference. For themed photo series, please send four to ten (4-10) images.
